

North American Coalition for Christian Admissions Professionals (NACCAP)

If an individual completes all six modules outlined by NACCAP and obtains NACCAP Certification, ACSI will allow that certification to replace the 12 semester hours of college credit in the “specific professional area” (School Counseling) required for the Professional Level Professional Staff certificate (meeting and exceeding the number of hours in school counseling required for the Standard Level certificate). The applicant would still have to meet all other certification requirements, including the 21 semester hours of college credit in general counseling or related field. A Temporary Level certificate, which is renewable, will be issued until the applicant completes all the certification requirements for the Standard Level.
