We are planning a special celebration for Day 100 of this school year. Over the next few days, please help your child to find a collection of 100 objects

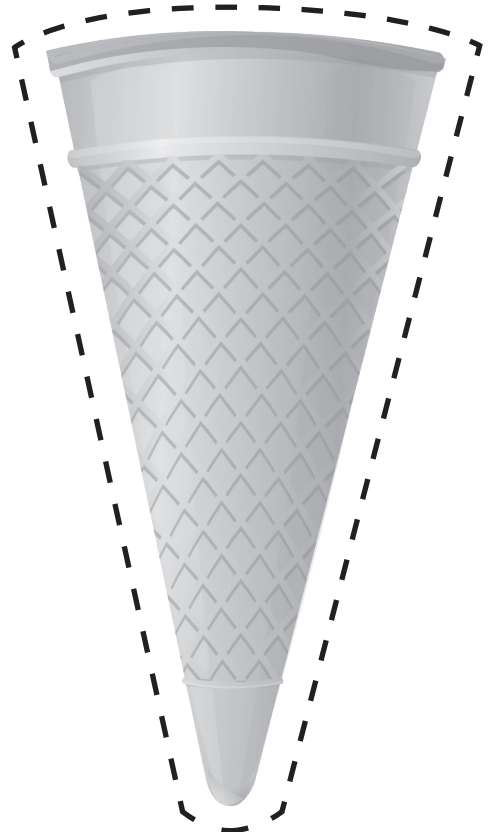
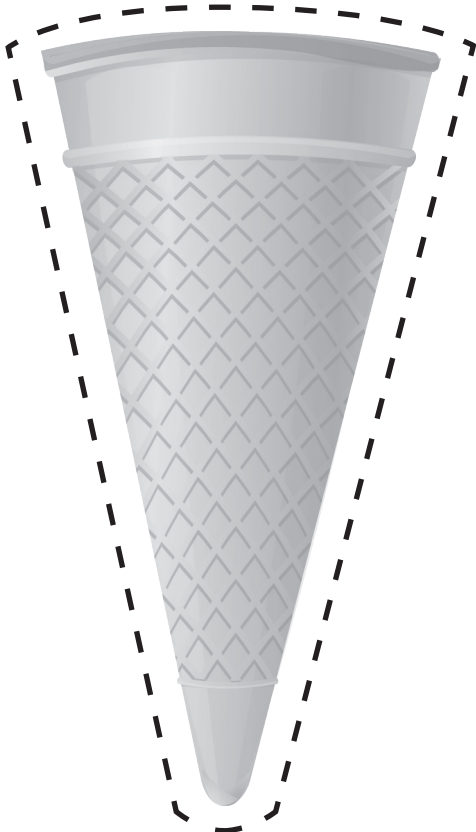
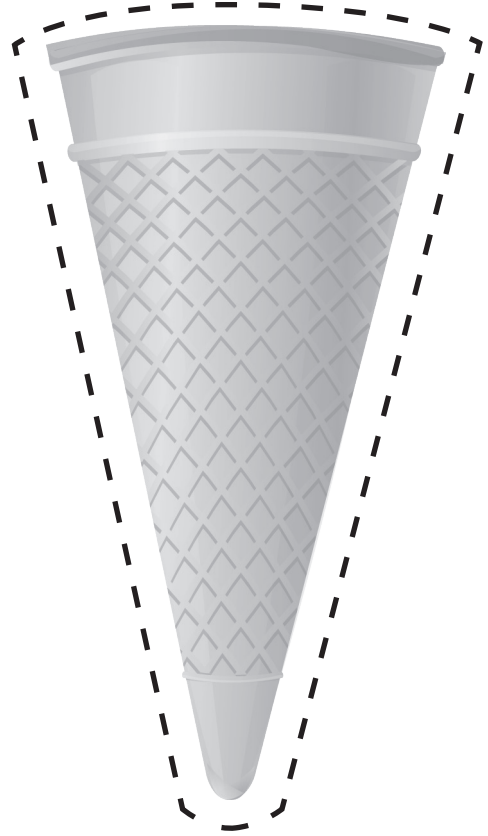
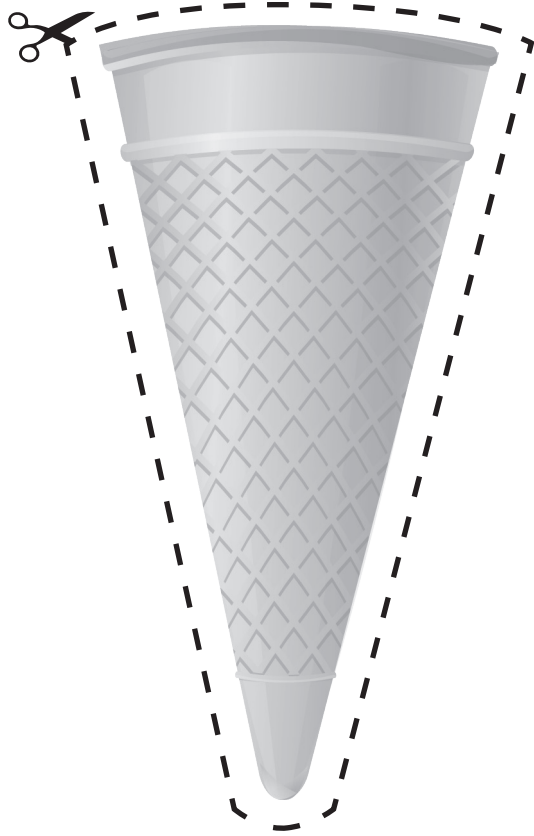

Thank you for all the ways you encourage your child to love learning!

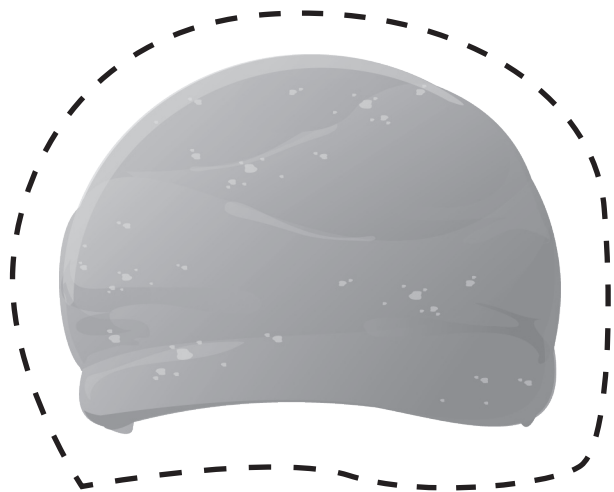
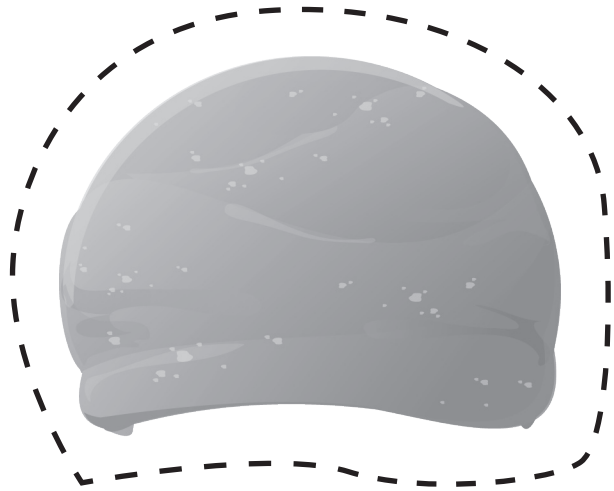
